OFFICIAL MINUTES**

March 25, 2020

The Board of County Commissioners, three members, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room. Rhonda Willard, County Clerk, was absent.

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Commissioner Lair led the flag salute.

AGENDA & MINUTES:

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as amended, and the minutes of March 18, 2020 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

COVID-19 (Coronavirus) UPDATE:

Destany Wheeler, Health Dept. Administrator, and Dr. Jennifer McKenney, County Health Officer, gave an update on the COVID-19. They also discussed Governor Kelly's most recent Executive Orders, and a possible Stay-at-Home order in the future depending on if the Pandemic worsens or a case is confirmed in the County.

COUNTY ATTORNEY'S REPORT:

Larry Markle, newly appointed County Attorney filling the unexpired term of Kenley Thompson, introduced himself to the Commissioners. He also inquired about the hourly rate for appeal work, which is \$75.00 per hour, and informed about an upcoming Child in Need of Care (CINC) appeal. He also discussed the Kansas Sentencing Guidelines.

COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, submitted the Census 2020 Boundary Validation Program form for the Chairman's signature.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the Chairman's signature for the Census 2020 BVP form. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
