He also discussed a request to change the stop signs at 4<sup>th</sup> Street & Bethel Road at Neodesha to stop Bethel Road traffic instead of 4<sup>th</sup> Street, and the Commission agreed by consensus to have a Resolution prepared as requested. He also submitted the monthly budget reports, and the November employee birthday cards for signature.
