

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS  
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

August 30, 2023

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of August 23, 2023 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**COORDINATOR'S REPORT:**

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented a request from the City of Neodesha to waive the landfill fees for the house demolition at 1211 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> in Neodesha. He also further discussed the proposals for the Sheriff's Department & 911 Dispatch hiring pay rates submitted by the Sheriff & 911 Director.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve waiving the landfill fees for the 1211 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> house demolition in Neodesha. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the Sheriff Deputies & Correction Officers hiring pay scale of \$14.50 to \$16.50 per hour depending on years of experience, and increasing the 911 Dispatcher hiring pay rate to \$15.00 per hour. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**COUNTY CLERK'S REPORT:**

Kayla Busch, County Clerk, reported that she resent the Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing Notices for the City of Neodesha at the cost of \$3,600.00.

**SEK INC. HOUSING CONFERENCE:**

Patty Ann Sanborn, SEK Inc. Director & Jeri Hammerschmidt, SEK Inc. Board Member, discussed the upcoming SEK Inc. Housing Conference to be held on November 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> at the Memorial Hall in Independence.
