

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

April 8, 2020

The Board of County Commissioners, three members, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room. Rhonda Willard, County Clerk, was absent.

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Commissioner Lair led the flag salute.

AGENDA & MINUTES:

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and the minutes of April 1, 2020 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, presented a right-of-way permit for Domestic Energy to clean out a ditch. He also discussed field drainage at US-400 & Gove Road. He also reported on ditch work at 1500 & Decatur Road and a request for ditch work at 700 & Scott Road.

COVID-19 (Coronavirus) UPDATE:

Destany Wheeler, Health Dept. Administrator, and Dr. Jennifer McKenney, County Health Officer, gave an update on the COVID-19. They reported that there are still no positive cases in Wilson County to date. They also discussed an estimated peak of the Pandemic on April 24th, but noted that the peak shouldn't be misinterpreted as the end. They also announced a new self-reporting online tool available on the Wilson County Health Department Facebook page. They also recommended wearing masks for precaution. They also informed of a Federal grant received in the amount of \$13,854.00 for reimbursement of COVID-19 Response by the Health Dept.

COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, submitted a \$0.50 per hour pay increase request for Craig Willett due to completing his introductory period.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the pay increase request for Craig Willett as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
