

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

December 9, 2020

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room. Rhonda Willard, County Clerk, was absent.

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Commissioner Lair led the flag salute.

AGENDA & MINUTES:

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of December 2, 2020 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, presented a right-of-way permit for ditching by Earl Porter. Also discussed truck traffic on Ottawa Road, a water drainage issue at 1600 & Harper Road, and disposing of some surplus property on Purple Wave. He also reported that CFS Engineers approved the inspection of the new bridge at 1925 & Decatur Road.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the ROW permits as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

COUNTY COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented a request from James Dunsworth to abate the property taxes of his house that was destroyed by fire. He also submitted a Neighborhood Revitalization application for Dawne Lowden & Chris Jabben. He also discussed the annual review of the County Solid Waste Management Plan.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the abate of property taxes of the house owned by James Dunsworth that was destroyed by fire, per K.S.A. 79-1613. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the NRP application for Dawne Lowden & Chris Jabben as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the annual review of the County SWMP with no changes for 2021. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS:

1. Approved warrants in the amount of \$6,858.33.
2. Reports received: Road & Bridge, Treasurer, and Attorney fee reports. 911 call log.
