

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

April 27, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

AGENDA & MINUTES:

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of April 20, 2022 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, presented a right-of-way permit for Neosho County RWD #6. He also submitted a request to dam water at 1200 & Gove Road, which was denied by consensus. He also reported on Back-hoe repairs, and still waiting on AT&T to relocate a telephone line for a bridge replacement. Commissioner Lair discussed the condition of South 4th Street near Neodesha.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the ROW request as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

SHERIFF'S REPORT:

Sheriff Jack Lucke, further discussed his proposal of reducing the number of Correction Officers per shift from 4 to 3, which would eliminate 4 positions and use the savings to increase the starting wage \$0.75 per hour.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, discussed a letter of compliance from KDHE for the Tulakes Sewer Facility inspection. He also presented a letter from KDOT commending Deputy Kenneth Robinson for his assistance at the K-39 Highway work zone. He also gave an update on ARPA.

OTHER BUSINESS:

1. Approved warrants in the amount of \$112,079.49.
